Training & Development: Monthly professional development sessions focused on skills that will help further advance your career, such as business writing and workplace communications.

Cohort Engagement: Regular meet ups with other co-op students to share your experiences and provide peer support for each other.

Mentorship: Access to Canfor's MentorMe program and be paired up with a Mentor to build meaningful relationships through one-on-one mentoring sessions with leaders at Canfor.

Professional projects: Create a presentation that addresses a specific business issue for the company and share your plan with company leadership. There is a unique chance to have your project be brought to life!


