CANFOR IS COMMITTED TO PROMOTE SUSTAINABLE FOREST MANAGEMENT BY CONDUCTING AND MAINTAINING OUR RISK ASSESSMENT PROGRAM FOR SOURCING WOOD FIBRE.

CANFOR WILL UPHOLD THE MANDATES IMPARTED BY THE FOREST STEWARDSHIP COUNCIL® IN RELATION TO SOURCING WOOD FIBRE. WE WILL TAKE ALL REASONABLE MEASURES TO AVOID SOURCING ROUND WOOD AND LUMBER FROM THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES:

1. Illegally harvested wood;
2. Wood harvested in violation of traditional and human rights;
3. Wood from forests in which high conservation values are threatened by management activities;
4. Wood from forests being converted to plantations or non-forest use;
5. Wood from forests in which genetically modified trees are planted; and
6. Wood harvested in violation of workers' rights and principles defined in the International Labour Organization (ILO) Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work.
